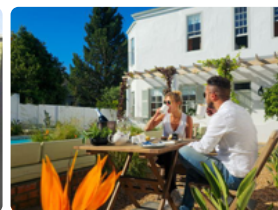
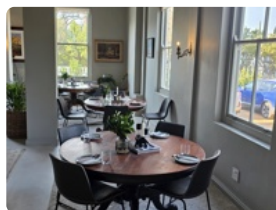

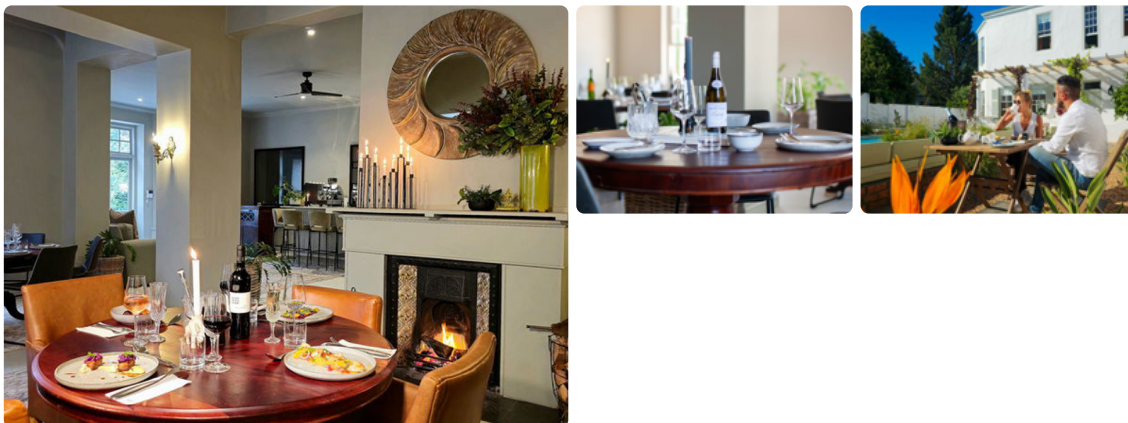

Kleinhoekkloof is an award-winning South African family owned boutique wine farm safely ensconced within the Langeberg Mountain range. Handcrafted wines are created here – wines that also reflect the superb quality of the fruit sourced from tiny wisps of vineyard. The farm has a rich family heritage .

Kleinhoekkloof is the ideal place for the wine, food and nature lover seeking an authentic and peaceful countryside experience. Kleinhoekkloof eagerly embraces the belief that farming in harmony with nature ensures that significant strides are made in protecting our precious natural heritage.

Charcuterie – the art of curing pork, traditionally done in France, Spain and Italy. Locally sourced pigs from natural and organic surroundings provide a natural basis for the process of this technique of curing meat naturally – the flavour and fat distribution is of utmost importance. Furthermore, the quality of the meat is determined by a few things; the breed, diet, exercise and stress.
